USAMRICD - Aberdeen Proving Ground, MD

[CHALLENGE]

The U.S. Army Corps of Engineers was scheduled to build a chemical defense complex at Aberdeen Proving Ground for the U.S. Army Medical Research Institute of Chemical Defense, USAMRICD, a government agency charged with protecting the military from chemical and biological attacks.

The 526,255-square-foot project, will include a central energy plant, administrative and support space, and new laboratories for work including animal testing. The project needed temporary modular space during construction.

[SOLUTION]

Modular Genius was selected by the Prime site development Contractor of this project to provide 10,000 sq ft of furnished modular office space. Modular Genius designed the space to fit the requirements. The foundation, modular installation and furniture was fabricated and installed within 90 days of award.
